

EXPEDITED HEARING CALENDAR

CIVIL AND FAMILY CASES

JUDGES MAHL, RAINWATER, ROBERTS, WOHN AND DAVIDSON

To facilitate the opportunity to set short hearings more quickly, the above listed judges each maintain an expedited hearing calendar. The following general rules apply to expedited hearings:

1. The expedited hearing calendar is reserved for matters that are uncontested, or if contested, can be resolved in less than 5 minutes.
2. All expedited hearings will be held in Courtroom 2C, Moore Justice Center.
3. Hearings shall be heard by the Judge assigned to the case. Hearings will be held in accordance with the schedule attached hereto, as may from time to time be updated.
4. The hearing calendar will start in accordance with the attached schedule, and will continue for 30 minutes, or until the last matter is heard, whichever occurs first.
5. The Court reserves the right to reschedule any matter that the judge considers too complex or too lengthy to be handled as an expedited hearing.
6. Telephone hearings are not permitted.
7. At least one party must appear at the hearing, and shall bring a proposed order with appropriate pre-addressed, stamped service envelopes.
8. Hearings will be handled on a first come- first served basis. Sign-in for the hearings will be available no later than 15 minutes prior to the scheduled start.
9. The expedited hearing shall not be formally scheduled with the Judicial Assistant or the Clerk of Court. However, the party setting the hearing shall coordinate the hearing with the opposing party, and shall give at least 5

business days notice of the hearing to the opposing party, in accordance with the Florida Rules of Civil Procedure.

10. As a general rule, court files will not be required for the hearing. Should a party desire that the court have the file, that party will be responsible for obtaining it. Files will not be ordered by either the clerk or the Judge's Judicial Assistant.
11. It shall be the responsibility of the party setting the expedited hearing to confirm before sending notice that the judge will be available. This may be done by calling the assigned judge's judicial assistant.
12. Each notice of hearing shall be plainly titled: "Notice of Hearing on Expedited Hearing Calendar", and shall contain the following certification: "The undersigned certifies that the hearing has been coordinated with the opposing party, and that the matter which is the subject of the hearing is either uncontested, or can be concluded in 5 minutes or less."
