### **ORDER SETTING CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE**

This action is taken by the court under the provisions of Rule 3.220(p).

IT IS ADJUDGED:

1. A case management conference is scheduled on (date) at (time) in the \_\_\_\_\_ County Courthouse, Courtroom \_\_\_\_.

2. Counsel of record shall be present at the case management conference and shall be prepared to discuss the following issues:

a. A date when written discovery will be provided to opposing counsel. (Rule 3.220a-d)

b. A date when lab analysis, forensic analysis or medical analysis will be completed. The State Attorney shall subpoena the person or persons in charge of forensic examinations for attendance at the hearing unless the State Attorney can provide a date forensic analysis will be completed and that date is within a reasonable time.

c. A deposition schedule.

d. A discovery cut off date.

e. A trial date.

f. Known evidentiary problems that will require court action including search and seizure, confessions or admissibility of scientific evidence.

g. Whether the State Attorney will seek the death penalty in this case.

3. The defendant shall be present at the case management conference unless a written waiver of presence has been filed with the court pursuant to Rule 3.180(a)(3).
